2. INSTITUTIONAL IDENTITY AND PUBLIC PURPOSE

- Kingdom of the Pearl is the public and institutional identity of the First Micronation of Women, Peace and Security born in Montes de María.
- NGO Foundation Kingdom of the Pearl is the legal and operational instrument through which the Kingdom enters into agreements, manages resources, implements projects, and assumes legal and contractual obligations.
- Its work is focused on strengthening women, peacebuilding, human rights, the Women, Peace and Security agenda, cooperation, research, and territorial development through a two-way relationship between the territory and the world.

3. GOVERNANCE AND RESPONSIBILITY

Legal and operational responsibility lies with NGO Foundation Kingdom of the Pearl and its competent governing bodies. The symbolic architecture of the Kingdom does not replace the legal structure of the Foundation.

General Assembly	Highest governing body of the legal entity, in accordance with the bylaws.
Board of Directors	Provides institutional direction and adopts the decisions assigned to it within the legal structure.
Legal Representation and Management	Lead institutional management and legally represent the Foundation.

4. TRANSPARENCY AND ACCESS TO DOCUMENTATION

The Foundation publishes essential institutional information and provides expanded documentation upon justified request and through secure channels. Some documents, such as signed financial statements, full bylaws, accounting certifications, or tax documentation, may be shared for due diligence, verification, or institutional partnership processes.
